## Babies

Babies have been experiencing lots of sensory play such as painting, coloured gloop and play dough. Winter colours have been used to extend visual experiences such as blue, white and grey. Light boxes and torches have been explored to show the differences between light, dark, shadows and shapes. We have had a big push in utilising the outdoors and ensuring the Babies get out and about on a daily basis. The photo on the front page shows the Babies at Eastleigh Train Station. The drivers slowed down and waved as they went past. A real live Thomas the Tank Engine!



## Toddlers

Toddlers have been focusing on different birds and bugs this came about after some play with shredded paper and the children began to build nests. To support this the children have been going out on trips to Manor Farm and Fleming Park. Toddlers have been on a bug hunt in the Garden, looking at books about bugs and making their own bugs out of pipe cleaners. This has been extended further by looking at birds from different environments such as penguins with the use of fake snow and ice.



## Transition

Transition have been out and about in Eastleigh looking for shapes in the environment such as square windows. They have also been exploring positional language such as on, under, in front, behind so the Team have been using opportunities in the children's small world play to promote this, such as commenting that 'you have put the cow next to the sheep' The Transition children have also taken an interest in matching objects together and played different types of matching games.



## Kindergarten

Kindergarten are looking at Hindu Festivals and linking this provocation with colour and light. We will be using flowers to introduce colour and harmony and different forms of light to look at contrasts and shadows. The children will be making their own kites and looking at different shapes to support their fine motor skills. The children will continue to work on their next steps over the month of February which mostly revolve around recognising numbers, letters and sounds.
